



Using the Microphone

Pull UP on the mic to release it from the post on the back of the unit. To return the mic, position it with the large hole over the post, then press downwards on the mic to secure it.

Be relaxed and ready to sing! Press the button on the microphone while singing or speaking. Release button to mute
